James E. West Fellowship

James E. West was the first Chief Scout Executive of the Boy Scouts of America, and served in that position for more than three decades. The West Fellowship award is available for gifts of \$1,000 and up, in cash or marketable securities, to the council endowment fund. The gift must be in addition to, and not replace or diminish, the donor's annual support.



Second Century Society

The Second Century Society recognition is presented for an outright gift of \$25,000 or more payable over five years, or a deferred gift of \$100,000 or more, to the Cascade Pacific Council for endowment, operating, or capital.
